## Mercy Sunday 27th April

Our Lord promised to grant complete forgiveness of sins and punishment on the Feast of Mercy. He is offering us a new start by granting a complete pardon, no matter how terrible our sins, if we sincerely repent and go to Confession, celebrate the feast on Mercy Sunday, receive Holy Communion on the day and place our complete trust in Jesus.

The other conditions for receiving this mercy are.

a) **Venerate the blessed Image** of Divine Mercy

b) **be merciful** to others through our actions, words and prayers on their behalf.

#### This opportunity occurs only once a year.

We are also able on this feast to gain a plenary indulgence for a Holy Soul in Purgatory.

A plenary indulgence omits the *whole* of the punishment due for sin. As well as Confession and Holy Communion there must be prayers for the intentions of the Pope, a spirit that is

detached from the affection for a sin and the intention to gain an indulgence.

So, we are twice blessed on this feast. Not only may we have the punishment due for our own sins wiped out, but also for one of the Holy Souls in Purgatory.
